I am submitting a comment today to speak against the approval of the following maps: Map 13a V.1, Map 13a V.5, and Map 13a V.6. Those maps if approved, would separate Mira Mesa and RPQ from the coastal board of supervisor district. Community leaders and neighborhood coalitions has spent years developing a relationship with their coastal county board supervisor. To remove Miramesa and RPQ would directly undo all of the work that community leaders have put in for the past several years. It is important to note that community leaders and neighborhood coalitions do not support these maps so neither should the IRC. The goal of the redistricting process is a to maintain proper representation for all communities and if these maps were to be approved the IRC would be failing to meet that goal.
