My name is Mike Anderson and I live in Lakeside. I'd like to thank the commission for their hard work on the redistricting maps. I would also like to express my appreciation that many of your draft maps keep our East County sister communities together such as Lakeside, Alpine, Jamul, Santee, Ramona and Poway, yet I am surprised that in some of your draft maps El Cajon, Rancho San Diego, and Spring Valley are not and have not been included in the East County district. Areas such as Lakeside, Ramona, Alpine and Santee, Jamul have shared economic, social, and cultural interests with El Cajon, Rancho San Diego and Spring Valley and we need to be kept together. I support Map 13a v.1-6 as it seems to reflect many of our community comments although I think changes could be made to include El Cajon in this district, as it is considered an East County community. I believe accounting for the population difference could be resolved by removing areas such as San Carlos, Navajo, Allied Gardens, Tierra Santa and even Scripps Ranch which seem to fit better in a coastal or central San Diego city district. Or by adding North County inland areas to a North County district. Thank you.
