I want to thank the Commissioners for the huge effort they have undertaken listening to the communities during these past few months. I am a part of the Communities Together Coalition supporting draft map 14, as it keeps communities of interest together & will make San Diego County stronger.

I've lived in Carlsbad for 14 years.

We've asked since the beginning of redistricting to be connected with our neighbors in the 78 corridor cities and many of your latest maps do not honor that request.

We share so much with North County cities which no one can argue.

None of the Map 13 options work for us. Map 13a divides the voices of coastal north county communities. Map 13A lumps our northern neighbor Oceanside with inland county cities. We are afraid that this will result in the north county coastal area diluting our collective voice at the county level. Map 13 also divides all of the communities of interest that we have been saying deserve the respect of being kept together for unified representation to best serve their needs.

We're not a part of urban San Diego and we're not a part of rural North County either – those areas have unique concerns and deserve their own representative and so do we.

Draft map 14 respects Carlsbad best.
