Although there is no perfect map, most variations of Map 14 reflect a range of community interests. We want to ensure that any variations do not compromise the communities of interest that have been submitted in the past months by community members and diverse organizations. Firstly, it's important to maximize AAPI voting power in the coastal district by keeping Mira Mesa, Rancho Penasquitos, Carmel Valley, Miramar, Linda Vista, Kearny Mesa together as our community has shared experiences, needs, and has been historically silenced. Secondly, it's important to maintain the proposed PANA district which keeps the core of BIPOC, Immigrant and Refugee community of interest together by uniting the City of El Cajon with City Heights, Spring Valley, Lemon Grove, La Mesa and Paradise Hills. It also keeps the LGBTQ communities together while creating a majority minority district which reflects the demography and cultural diversity of San Diego's central region.
