My name is Tracy Morgan Hollingworth and I work in El Cajon. I want to thank the commission for their hard work and express my appreciation that many of your draft maps keep many East County sister communities together such as Lakeside, Alpine, Jamul, Santee, Ramona and Poway. I am surprised that in some of your draft maps El Cajon, Rancho San Diego, and Spring Valley are not and have not been included in East County. Areas such as Lakeside, Ramona, Alpine, Santee and Jamul have shared economic, social, and cultural interests with El Cajon, Rancho San Diego and Spring Valley and need to be kept together. Map 13a v.1-6 seems to reflect many of our community comments and I would support this map but some changes to it to reflect Communities of Interest would be to restore El Cajon into East County once more. If you need to account for the population difference you can remove areas such as San Carlos, Navajo, Allied Gardens, Tierra Santa and even Scripps Ranch which seem to fit better in a central San Diego city district.
