I am very displeased to see the Skyline Drive area east of Woodman placed into District 1 instead of District 4. That area has little in common with District 1. I should know, I grew up there and my mother still has a home there. This is not meant as a slight to District 1. The South Bay has much to offer. But it is powered and centered in Chula Vista and not the City of San Diego, which will leave the Skyline Drive area forgotten and isolated. I believe the line for Districts 1 and 4 should be moved south to Paradise Valley Road. And if one of the reasons of putting El Cajon and La Mesa in the same district as southeastern San Diego was to increase Black voter participation, removing the Skyline Drive area east of Woodman makes zero sense. Please re-think this and change it as I suggested. Thanks.
