I am a resident of Mira Mesa and a member of the Communities Together Coalition. I want to take a moment to thank the commissioners for your dedication to what at times must feel like a thankless job. While draft map 13A was not my first choice, this most recent iteration does appear to address some of the issues that were brought up last Thursday. I am very pleased to see that you kept El Cajon aligned with the other high immigrant communities in City Heights, Lemon Grove and La Mesa. I do have a remaining concern that Kearny Mesa and Linda Vista are cut off from the rest of the AAPI community, though. Separating those two neighborhoods from the AAPI community significantly dilutes their vote and opportunity to elect someone who represents AAPI concerns. However, I am very happy to see the Asian communities of Mira Mesa, Rancho Penasquitos, Carmel Valley and Sorrento Valley mapped to the coastal district, which shares much of the same urban concerns as Mira Mesa, et al. As you make your final adjustments, please look for ways to bring in the rest of the predominately Asian neighborhoods into one consolidated district. Thank you for all of the time and effort you have given to serve our communities.
