On behalf of the Surfrider Foundation San Diego County Chapter, I would like to urge this Commission to take the opportunity to ensure there is a coastal district that spans North County and the Southern Part of the County. Surfrider is a non-profit focused on the coastal issues that affect the entire region - including sand loss, loss of coastal access caused by development patterns, and clean water issues. By redistricting to include a coastal district, the County could provide an opportunity to help better manage flows of pollution to the coast, help coordinate sand and develop policies related to erosion and land use that will nourish the beach, and also oversee development in a way that allows beaches to continue to exist after 2030 (currently the vast majority of Southern California beaches are expected to be swallowed by sea level rise if no action is taken.) Sand and sea level rise do not know borders and municipalities need a unifying body to help with this management and related policies. On behalf of our more than 2,300 members, we request this Commission please consider a large coastal district. Thank you, Laura Walsh.
