Dear Commissioners,

I have resided in multiple coastal cities in north county San Diego for well over 10 years. My recommendation for redistricting is to create a new District 5 to represent the following cities: Carlsbad, San Marcos, Oceanside, Vista, Escondido.

-It's important to keep the City of Escondido together in the redistricting lines. This provides greater representation for Latino communities.

-Keep the cities aligned to the SR 76 and SR78 together. These are major traffic pathways that allow travel from east to west and vice versa. This pathway also serves many businesses where residents commute from all of these cities.

-Keep the cities aligned to Tri City hospital. This is the only community hospital in the area with mental health beds and needs to continue to serve these cities.

-There is Miracosta college and San Marcos university that serve all the cities I recommend for D5.

-The two coastal cities shares resources with the inland cities. Oceanside and Carlsbad expands east working with San Marcos and Vista. Keeping these cities together ensures we have representation on environmental issues impacting our ocean as well as our open space.

-These cities are all impacted by the Palomar airport and we need to ensure our concerns regarding the expansion are represented.

-These cities are home to many military members that are stationed at Camp Pendleton.

-These cities are served by the North County Transit Department.

-All of these cities face issues with the unhoused and we should continue to work together to address the issues faced by the unhoused community.

Our demographics are changing as will be determined by the 2020 census results. We need to ensure the Latino community in North County San Diego are represented by these maps. I believe having these cities aligned in one district will help in representing Latino communities. In addition, all of these cities have several commonalities and share resources.
