Hello, my name is Maya Misra and I am a resident of Ocean Beach. My OB community consists of military veterans and people who care deeply for the environment and animal welfare. Being a coastal community on the peninsula, we are uniquely impacted by cliff erosion and climate change. I am writing because I strongly believe that Ocean Beach should be in the same district as Point Loma and Coronado. Asian, Black, and Latinx folks in areas of South San Diego have struggled to secure adequate representation for their diverse communities, due in no small part to the district lines that ensure they are always competing with wealthier and more privileged people for a political voice. When previous Supervisors split the peninsula in half to include Point Loma and Coronado in District 1 with Chula Vista and other areas, they did not have the interests of community members from the peninsula or South San Diego in mind. The people of Ocean Beach have far more in common with Point Loma and Coronado, namely due to similar demographics (by which I mean military veterans, as well as primarily white populations) and concerns over cliff erosion and coastal environmental preservation. My OB community is closely tied with the rest of Point Loma, and I advocate for these areas staying together alongside Coronado.
