I have a little feedback on the neighborhoods of the current district 5 and district 3:

Regarding District 5

- North County is a “community of interest” -- meaning we share many common North County institutions such as government agencies, health care entities, youth sports leagues and social & cultural institutions. We are distinct from the City of San Diego and other places in the county.
  - Communities like Fallbrook, Valley Center and Bonsall are all essential parts of North County. We are connected to the cities of North County and we have a regional identity that is different from the City of San Diego or East County or South County.
  - Separating our unincorporated areas from North County violates our community of interest.
  - Our coastal, urban and rural areas are interconnected – by transportation (like North County Transit and Highways 78 & 76), health care providers and employers.
  - Respect our community of interest and maintain a unified North County, represented by one County Supervisor.
- Some examples of the overlapping government agencies in North County:
- The Sheriff's Department patrols both Unincorporated communities and the cities of Vista and San Marcos.
  - San Marcos Fire Department services both the City of San Marcos and unincorporated communities.
  - Vallecitos Water District services both unincorporated communities and portions of the City of San Marcos.
  - Vista Irrigation District (the water district) services the City of Vista, unincorporated communities AND portions of the City of San Marcos.
  - The San Marcos School Districts serves students in the City of San Marcos, some Unincorporated areas AND part of the City of Carlsbad.
  - The Bonsall School District, in an Unincorporated community, also educates students in part of the City of Oceanside.

Regarding District 3

And finally as a resident of District 3 I can express my disappointment that the lines of our district span from my neighborhood in Scripps Ranch all the way to the coast and up the coast. We need to be placed with the inland communities of Poway (who we even share schools and lots of club sports with), Ramona (whose residents commute through scripps ranch to go to work etc.) and towards Tierrasanta. Our communities face the seasonal fire threat and being able to work together with those in similar climate and risk is helpful.
