For many years, District 3 has been an important part of my social network, as my friends, fellow students/teachers, and organizing community meet here for countless meals and social gatherings at a number of restaurants, tea shops, and spas. This area holds historical significance for AAPI communities who have lived and worked in the district for generations, and we must act to protect their legacy and voices for years to come. Currently, this community faces rapidly rising housing costs, ongoing struggles for small businesses in the midst of the COVID pandemic, and rising anti-Asian racism. I urge you to draw district lines that respect API San Diegans' communities of interest and empower our community. Many of San Diego's API residents and businesses are currently in District 3 and centered in the neighborhoods of Mira Mesa, Sorrento Valley, Kearny Mesa, the Convoy St commercial corridor, Miramar and Rancho Penasquitos. There has been significant progress in the City's redistricting process to empower AAPI communities such as District 3 that have been historically under-represented, and I hope that the county will take a similar approach.
