It's not clear what action you'll be taking on the timeline today, but we want to confirm that the timeline will be a living document, particularly since you have not yet received training on what is required for the redistricting process and discussed how you want to conduct that process.

For example, the proposed timeline lays out 5 post-draft map hearings. However, 5 hearings is the minimum required by law. You may decide that you will have more hearings, given there are 3 million people in the county, and there is tremendous diversity within each supervisorial district.

Public presentations: It's great to see that the timeline includes ongoing, more formal presentations by community groups and the public. We'd appreciate it if you could share what you envision is the process for groups to request time for those presentations and who they should reach out to for more information. On behalf of LWV San Diego: This week, the Census Bureau announced that its release of apportionment data to the states would be delayed until at least the beginning of March, if not later. This delay directly impacts the date by which the state and local jurisdictions will receive adjusted Census data for redistricting purposes.

The timeline for your redistricting process that is currently being proposed would not allow enough time for meaningful public engagement in light of the delayed Census data release date and uncertainty.

Given the ongoing uncertainty, we urge you to create a working timeline that has December 15, 2021, as your map adoption deadline, and that you work backwards from that date to determine your windows for pre-and post-mapping public engagement, as well as the critical time period after Census data is released when you will use new Census data to conduct racially polarized voting analysis and assess Voting Rights Act compliance.

The state legislature extended your deadline for final map adoption to December 15, 2021 - with support from the County of San Diego -- for the same reason the California Supreme Court extended the deadline for the state's adoption of final maps to December 15th: Covid, and the challenges it presented for the Census, created uncertainty and delays. An extended - and CERTAIN - deadline facilitates efficient planning, ensures the commission will have the time it needs to engage the public in the more challenging Covid environment, and gives other stakeholders, including community organizations, the certainty they need to plan for and engage the public in the redistricting process.
