# Overview of Key Milestones: 2021 Redistricting Timeline

(Items in bold print relate to specific statutory requirements)

### January - March 2021

IRC organizational matters/training

- Adopt regular meeting schedule
- Approve approach to translation services
- Approve website design and content maintenance
- Establish desired subcommittees
- Establish and publish general timeline for redistricting process
- Conduct procurement process for outreach and demographic/mapping services (note, additional services may be required, e.g. racially polarized voting analysis)
- Training for Commissioners and the public
- Presentations by members of the public (as requested)

April 2021 -- California receives federal Census data (may be delayed)
April 30, 2021: Estimated date for County to receive adjusted Census data

- (Tent.)Complete contracts for demographic/mapping and outreach services
- Develop outreach plan and mapping activities plan with contractors

### May - June 2021

Pre-mapping period & first draft maps

- Approve Public Outreach Plan\*
- Approve Plan for Commission and Public Mapping Activities
- Begin Pre-Mapping Public Hearings (minimum seven, suggest one in each supervisorial district
- Identify communities of interest
- Adopt redistricting criteria
- Direct demographic/mapping consultant to produce first set of draft redistricting maps
- Open period for members of public, using public mapping tool, to submit draft maps based on Census data, criteria, and communities of interest
- Commence Commission process of analysis and directed modifications to draft redistricting maps
- Commence Public Hearing on draft maps, suggest one in each of the five existing supervisorial districts

### July – August 2021

Map Development Period

- Continue Public Hearings in each of the five existing supervisorial districts
- Receive draft maps submitted by members of public
- Continue Commission process of analysis and directed modifications to draft redistricting maps (could include map(s) submitted by a member of the public)
- Hold Public Hearing(s) in connection selection of the IRC's preferred final draft redistricting map
- Draft resolution to adopt a final redistricting map
- Send IRC's preferred final draft redistricting map data to Registrar of Voters for 30-day review (late August)
- Begin drafting statutorily required report on compliance with statutory criteria in the final redistricting map

### September – October 2021

Period for finalizing redistricting map

- Public Hearing to approve any technical adjustments to Commission's preferred final redistricting map (late September)
- Approve resolution adopting final redistricting map and the final statutorily-required report
- 30-day referendum period begins
- Ensure full record of Commission proceedings archived on the internet

### November 2021

Redistricting map final

- Close of 30-day referendum period
- File the plan with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors
- Send adopted redistricting map in appropriate GIS file to Registrar of Voters to draw precincts and prepare for 2022 elections

Commission and election deadlines and wind-down activities

December 15, 2021: Statutory deadline for IRC to adopt a final map of supervisorial district boundaries

December 16, 2021: First day for candidates to collect signatures (for petition in lieu of filing fee) for 2022 election

- Draft and approve a "lessons learned" document for 2031 Independent Redistricting Commission

### February 2022

February 14, 2022: First day for candidates to circulate nomination papers for 2022 election

Pre-mapping public hearings with focus on communities of interest (7 total over period of no less than 30 days)

### July – August 2021

Continue pre-mapping public hearings

California receives federal Census data by 7/31/2021

County to receive adjusted Census data by 8/31/2021

No draft IRC map published until 3 weeks after receipt of adjusted Census data Public mapping

# Planning Ahead for Census Delays -2

### September – October 2021

IRC map development; post-mapping public hearings (2 min. over period of no less than 30 days)

Select map for adoption; ROV expedited map review; finalize map Final adoption by 10/31/2021

### November - December 2021

Referendum period

### December 2021

Commission and election deadlines and wind-down activities

December 15, 2021: Statutory deadline for IRC to adopt a final map

December 16, 2021: First day for candidates to collect in lieu

# <u>Comparison – Major Differences</u>

## May - June 2021

Pre-mapping public hearings conducted <u>without</u> benefit of Census data

No draft IRC maps produced

## July – August 2021

Approx. 4-month delay in receipt of Census data (orig. April 1, 2021)

## September – October 2021

IRC Draft mapping delayed by approx. 3 months or more (orig. June 2021)

IRC map development and finalization (orig. early Aug. 2021), incl.

ROV review, compressed into two months

Final adoption by 10/31/2021 (orig. late Sept. 2021)

# November – December 2021

Referendum period orig. October – November 2021
