




- Districts 1 had a higher number of residents from *outside* their districts RSVP and attend their sessions.
- Districts 3, 4, and 5 had a higher numbers of residents from *within* their districts RSVP and attend their sessions.


Start & End of Webinar Polling Scores:

"On a scale from 0 to 4, how much do you know about redistricting?"













Start & End of Webinar Polling Scores:

"On a scale from 0 to 4, how important do you think Redistricting is?"






