Specifically I believe that Camp Pendleton, Oceanside, Vista, Fallbrook, Bonsall and Rainbow are a "Community of Interest" due to the strong military ties.</p> <p>Many active duty and retired military families make their home in this region. Because of the unique needs of military families, it is imperative that they have a strong voice at all levels of government. As a specific example, military families have very specific needs regarding the education of their children. Schools must promote quality education for military children by working with base command, families, and family support agencies. It is critical that government and volunteer programs address the unique needs of our military families. Having representatives focus on ensuring these kinds of programs are available at the state and federal level is important. By keeping this important community of interest together, we can ensure a strong voice for our military families who sacrifice to much for all of us. We'd like to be linked to the west side jurisdictions (Encinitas, Rancho Santa Fe, San Marcos).</p> <p>This is an unincorporated island in the County of San Diego stretching from Encinitas/San Marcos/ Rancho Santa Fe to Escondido. We are a rural, equestrian, agricultural community sandwiched between urban / suburban areas. We value a rural environment, open space, conservation, environmental stewardship, fire safety and we have many community events to celebrate the community. We have an annual fourth of july parade festival (45 years running), a yearly trail run event (the Keepin' it Rural 5k10k), community clean ups and other events every year. We actually have a community plan in the County of San Diego and we are a distinct community within the San Dieguito subarea with a clearly defined map. <p>Clairemont</p> <p>The surrounding freeways play a major part in demarcating the community and should be taken into account when drawing the district. Because of the topography and the shared public resources, the Clairemont district should unite the entire mesa, from the 5 to the west, to the 52 to the north, to the 805 and 163 to the east, down to the 8 in the south.</p> <p>Bay Ho and Bay Park should be considered part of Clairemont, as should all of the Mount streets and the Morena district. Adjacent areas that could be a part of the same district are Linda Vista and University City. One area that should not be part of the same district is Mira Mesa, because of its distance and because its needs are so different from Clairemont's. The inclusion of Mira Mesa in the same district has diverted attention and funding from Clairemont.</p> <p>Clairemont is a family-oriented community located on a mesa in central San Diego, bounded by the 52 to the north, the 5 to the west, and the 805 to the east. Because of its post-war construction and well-designed access to shopping, schools, and public spaces, it is a place where people move to raise their children. Much of the future of Clairemont needs to be oriented toward encouraging and supporting young families through the improvement and expansion of schools, libraries, parks, and mass transit. Many areas are due for redevelopment because of their age and outdated designs.
