Proposed Amendment to IRC Bylaws (subject to revisions)

That the Bylaws and Operating Procedures of the County of San Diego Independent Redistricting Commission be amended to add section 5.07 to Article V to provide as follows:

Section 5.07. **Authority of Officers Regarding Final Redistricting Plan**. If in consultation with the County of San Diego Registrar of Voters, it is determined technical adjustments to the district boundaries of the final redistricting plan approved by the commission or the resolution adopting the final redistricting plan are necessary to implement the intent of the plan or the resolution, and such adjustments do not involve any population or change the intent of the plan as adopted, the Officers may, subject to ratification by the commission, approve such technical adjustments and shall forthwith advise the commission.
