At the request of the County of San Diego Independent Redistricting Commission for Racially Polarized Voting analysis, FLO Analytics has engaged in discussions with seven academic researchers, specialized in Racially Polarized Voting Analysis (RPV) to perform a RPV study in support of the County's Supervisorial Districts redistricting process. Dr. McDonald and Dr. Amos will collaborate on the project and submit one proposal. The proposals will include a project approach, task and hours estimates, and an overall cost. We expect to receive the proposals within the next week. Once received, FLO will evaluate the proposals and make a selection subject to the approval requirements in section 1.4 of its Contract with the County. A draft a memo summarizing our evaluation process will accompany the recommendation.
