JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND SAN DIEGO COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS AUTHORIZING USE OF COUNTY RESOURCES TO ENSURE CONTINUANCE OF FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2020 (1), the County of San Diego Board of Supervisors (Board of Supervisors) initiated proceedings with the San Diego Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) to form the San Diego County Fire Protection District (SDCFPD);

WHEREAS, on December 7, 2020, LAFCO finalized the formation of SDCFPD;

WHEREAS, the San Diego County Fire Authority (Fire Authority) previously provided fire services through County Service Area No. 135 (CSA 135);

WHEREAS, SDCFPD is a separate legal entity from the County of San Diego (County) now responsible for providing fire protection and emergency medical services within the CSA 135 area;

WHEREAS, SDCFPD requires support from the County to continue providing these critical services; and

WHEREAS, the County agrees that such support is essential to ensure the continued provision of these services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego and the Board of Directors of the San Diego County Fire Protection District that, to the extent permitted by law and required for SDCFPD to provide fire protection and emergency medical services:

- 1. The County's Chief Administrative Officer is hereby appointed Executive Director of the SDCFPD, and the Deputy Chief Administrative Officer Public Safety Group or designee shall serve as Deputy Director of the SDCFPD.
- 2. County officers and employees, when acting for the benefit of the SDCFPD, shall serve as ex officio officers and employees of SDCFPD.
- 3. In accordance with County Board Policy A-87, Competitive Procurement, the Director of the County Department of Purchasing and Contracting is authorized to enter into negotiations on behalf of SDCFPD with Water Districts, Cities, Joint Powers Agencies/Authorities, recognized Tribal Governments, and other Fire Protection Districts, subject to successful negotiations and a determination of a fair and reasonable price, award a contract or contracts for fire and emergency medical

- services and operating goods through June 30, 2023, and may amend the contract or contracts as needed to reflect changes to requirements and funding.
- 4. On behalf of SDCFPD, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to execute revenue agreements with Fire Protection Districts, Water Districts, Cities, Joint Powers Agencies/Authorities, and recognized Tribal Governments for fire and emergency medical services.
- 5. Except as otherwise expressly provided, SDCFPD shall comply with all applicable County laws, policies, and procedures.
