WATER SAFETY TIPS



Swimming Lessons

formal swimming lessons can reduce the risk of drowning



Enclose Pools

use a four-sided fence to fully enclose pool with a self-closing and latching gate



Supervise Closely

designate a responsible adult to supervise closely and constantly when children are in or near water



Learn CPR

your CPR skills could save someone's life in the time it takes for paramedics to arrive

For added measure, County Fire will give you a *FREE POOL ALARM* if you live in the San Diego County or Deer Springs Fire Protection District!



The product is a battery-operated device with remote receiver, designed to sound an alarm should a child or pet fall into a pool *limited quantity available*
