- In addition to ongoing regional homeless outreach, HCDS-OHS participates in community events and responds to community, CAO and BOS referrals.
- Those included 3,659 engagements, 38 connections to housing, and 805 self-sufficiency transitions.
- Engagements are duplicated; Self-Sufficiency transactions and connections to housing are unduplicated.
