Meeting Called to Order at 10:23 AM by Chairperson Carol Wollas affirming a quorum. All members present.

    - 1. Five-year Plan Goals Progress Report including new funding/vouchers for vulnerable households, resources and activities for participants and landlord outreach.
    - 2. Significant Changes for the Draft FY 2021-22 Administrative Plan
      - Translation Services to Limited-English Proficient (LEP) households will include Arabic and Spanish language groups for core documents-defined
      - **Criminal Prohibition Periods** changed from 5 years to 3 years for discretionary denials for some offenses
      - Subsidy Standards Exception Policy-added evaluation criteria for households requesting an exception to the subsidy standards and meeting a health and safety reason

- **Communication to Owners** Outreach communication must ensure equal access by landlords that are Limited-English Persons or having a disability connected communication need.
- Special Programs-Moderate Rehabilitation Added descriptive language for planned conversion activities under the Rental Assistance Demonstration project.
- Informal Reviews and Hearings- Remote communication options added to allow remote interviews and electronic document submission
- **Special Local Preference limits** Increased limit for homeless referrals from 750 to 1000.
- 3. Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy (ACOP) Significant Changes and Capital Fund Report
  - Flat and Maximum Rents- Updated rents for all bedroom sizes
  - Reasonable Accommodation Policy—Added policy defining criteria for determining service and/or support animals
  - Terminations for Over-Income—Updated chart and added a waiver to the requirement to terminated residents over 120% of Area Median Income (AMI)
    - o Due to covid-19 situation, policy is waived, for time-being.
  - Appeals—-Added Remote options for hearings
  - **Criminal Prohibition Periods**—Added three-year prohibition period for acts of bribery; Changed the prohibition period for some drug and violent criminal activity from five years to three years
- 4. Capital Fund Update
  - \$253,000
    - Replace electrical service and and distribution services at Chula Vista Towncenter
  - \$2.9 M allocated by County for Public Housing sites for building improvements
