TENANT COMMISSIONER RECRUITMENT – GENERAL SEAT ANNOUNCEMENT

The Housing Authority of the County of San Diego (HACSD) is currently recruiting for an upcoming Tenant Commissioner opening on its Board of Commissioners (Board). The opening is for the General Seat.

The Board is the governing body of HACSD and is comprised of the five members of the County of San Diego Board of Supervisors and two Tenant Commissioners. As the governing body, the Board oversees the administration of the Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) and Public Housing Programs and is responsible for approving program activities, such as the Agency Plan, the annual budget, requests for funding, changes in program administration and implementation of new housing programs.

As a resident of HACSD Public Housing or a participant of the HACSD Section 8 HCV program, you may be eligible for appointment to HACSD's Board as a Tenant Commissioner.

Term of Office

Each Tenant Commissioner serves a two-year term. The new term for the **General Seat** begins June 1, 2026.

Eligibility for Tenant Commissioner General Seat Selection

- Must be a resident of the HACSD Public Housing or a participant in HACSD Section 8 HCV Program. This includes Project Based Vouchers (PBV) and Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing (VASH).
- Must be in good standing with HACSD, i.e. meeting all family obligations under the Public Housing or Section 8 program and free from official sanctions for violations of the rules and regulations of the Section 8 HCV or Public Housing Programs.
- Must be listed on the lease.
- Must be 18 years old or older.
- Must be willing to participate in training and orientation.
- Must be willing to attend meetings of the Board of Commissioners.
- Must avoid conflicts of interest and abide by the Board's policies ([Board of Supervisors Rules of Procedure](#)).

In order to maintain continuing eligibility, Tenant Commissioners must adhere to the County's Statement of Values and support HACSD's mission of efficiently providing public services that build strong and sustainable communities.

Selection Process

Tenant Commissioner applications from participants of the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher program and Public Housing residents will be accepted on or before **Tuesday, March 3, 2026**. Each completed application submitted to HACSD will be evaluated for relevant experience, pertinent knowledge, and interest in serving the community. Based on the criteria listed above, several qualified applicants will be selected for interviews. Following the interviews, a criminal background review and a review of the tenant's program record for violations of the rules and regulations will be conducted for the top candidates. A candidate will be recommended by the Housing Authority to the County of San Diego Board of Supervisors for appointment.
