# Why a Climate Action Plan?

- The County's 2011 General Plan recognized the relationship between local greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and climate change
- The General Plan EIR contained mitigation strategies consistent with AB 32-Global Warming Solutions Act
- The CAP mitigates emissions within the unincorporated areas of the County and Countyowned facilities
- The County prepared 2012 CAP and 2018 CAP in prior iterations





### **Board Direction**

- Legally enforceable
- No purchase of carbon offsets to meet emission reduction targets
- Updated data and modeling
- Emphasizes environmental justice and equity
- Shaped by community input
- Exceeds Senate Bill 32 greenhouse gas emissions reductions
- Meets net zero carbon emissions by 2035-2045
- Receive input and direction from the Environmental Advisory Committee







# **Greenhouse Gas Emissions Inventory**




## **Emissions Forecasts and Reduction Targets**




