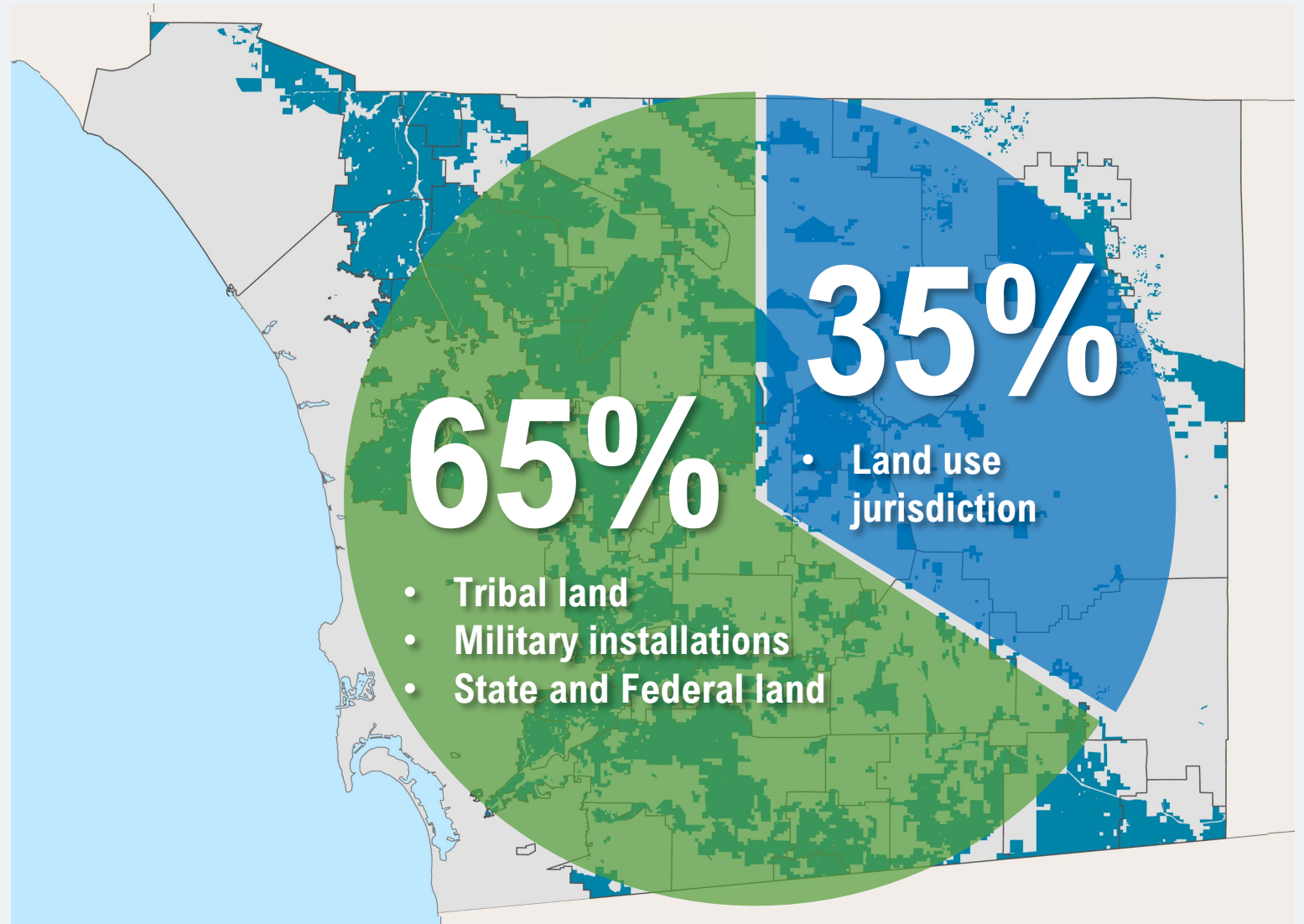
Framework for Bold Climate Action at the County of San Diego

“Establish actions to meet a goal of net zero carbon emissions by 2035-2045”

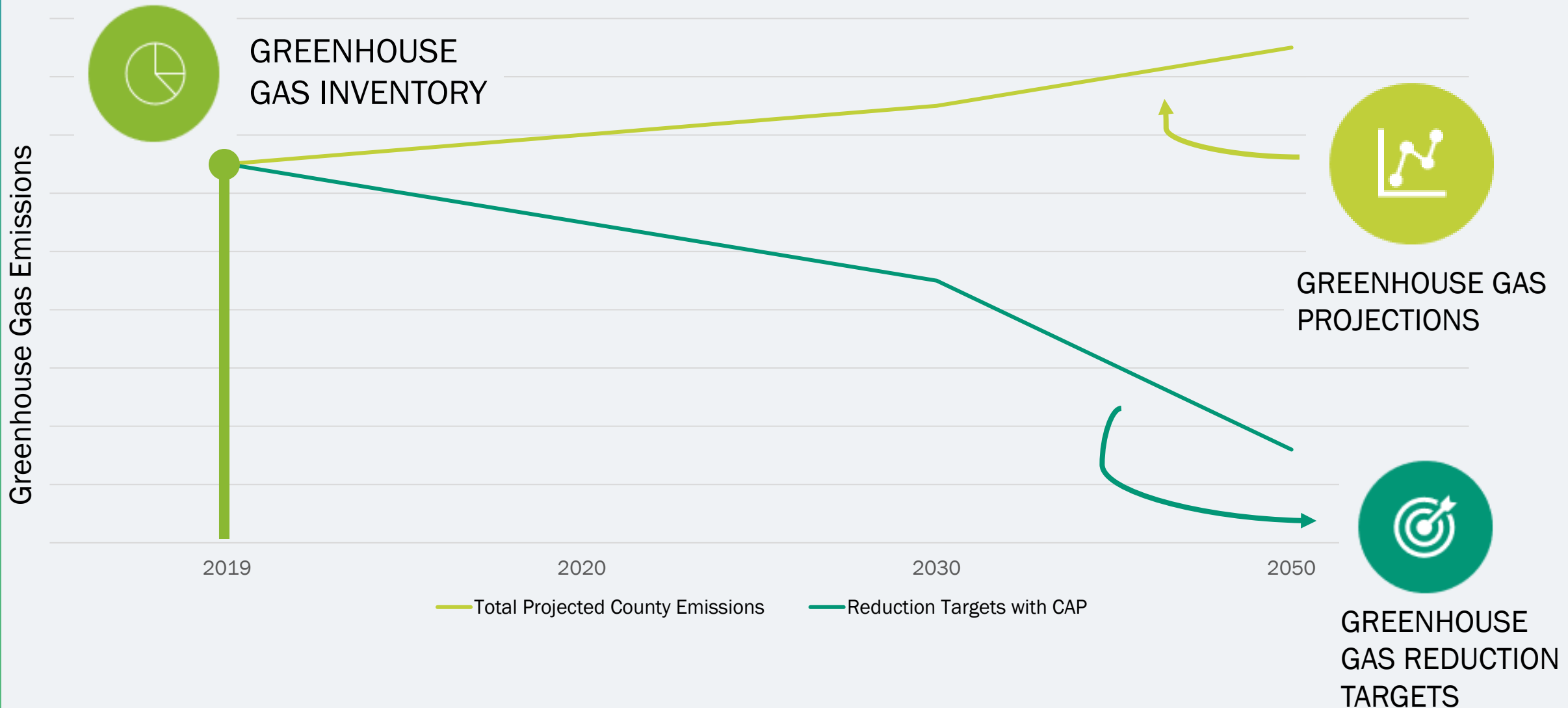


County of San Diego General Plan

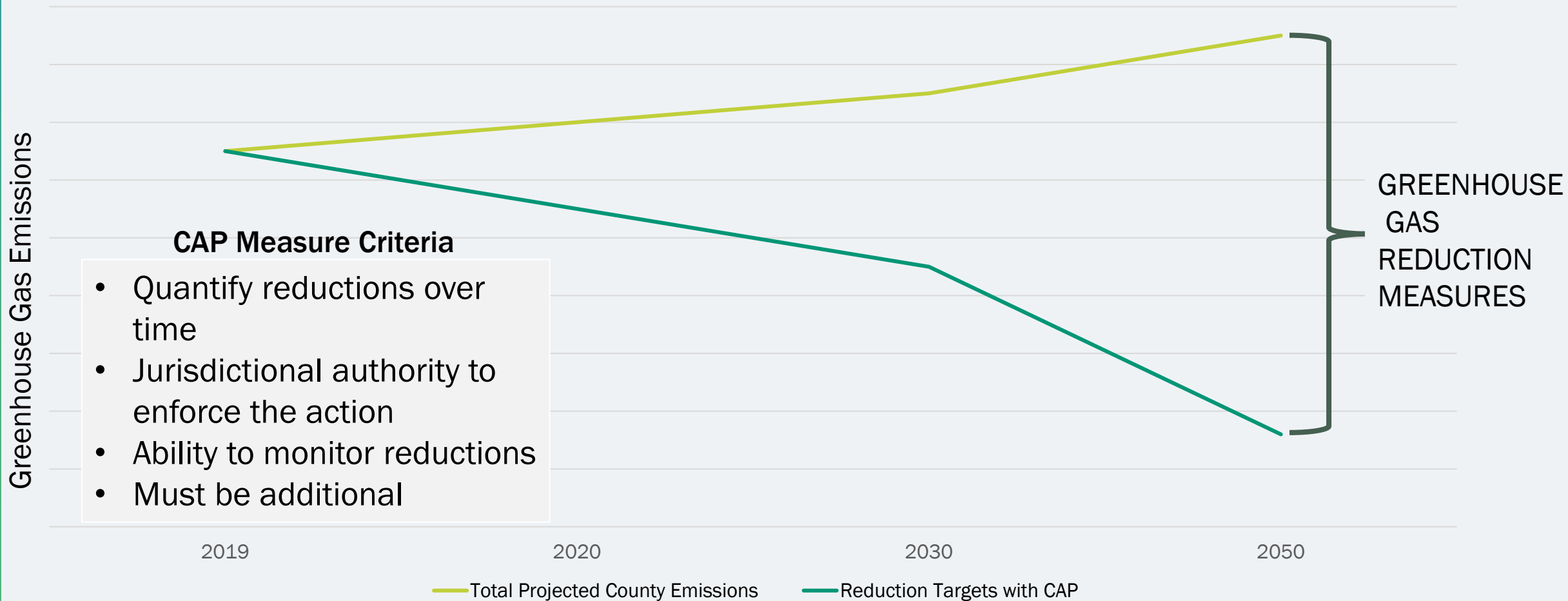
- 2011 General Plan reduced residential capacity by 15%
- Concentrates 80% of dwelling unit capacity closest to cities
- County area: 2.9 million acres
- Unincorporated area: 2.2 million acres
- Land use jurisdiction over 772,239 Acres or 35%

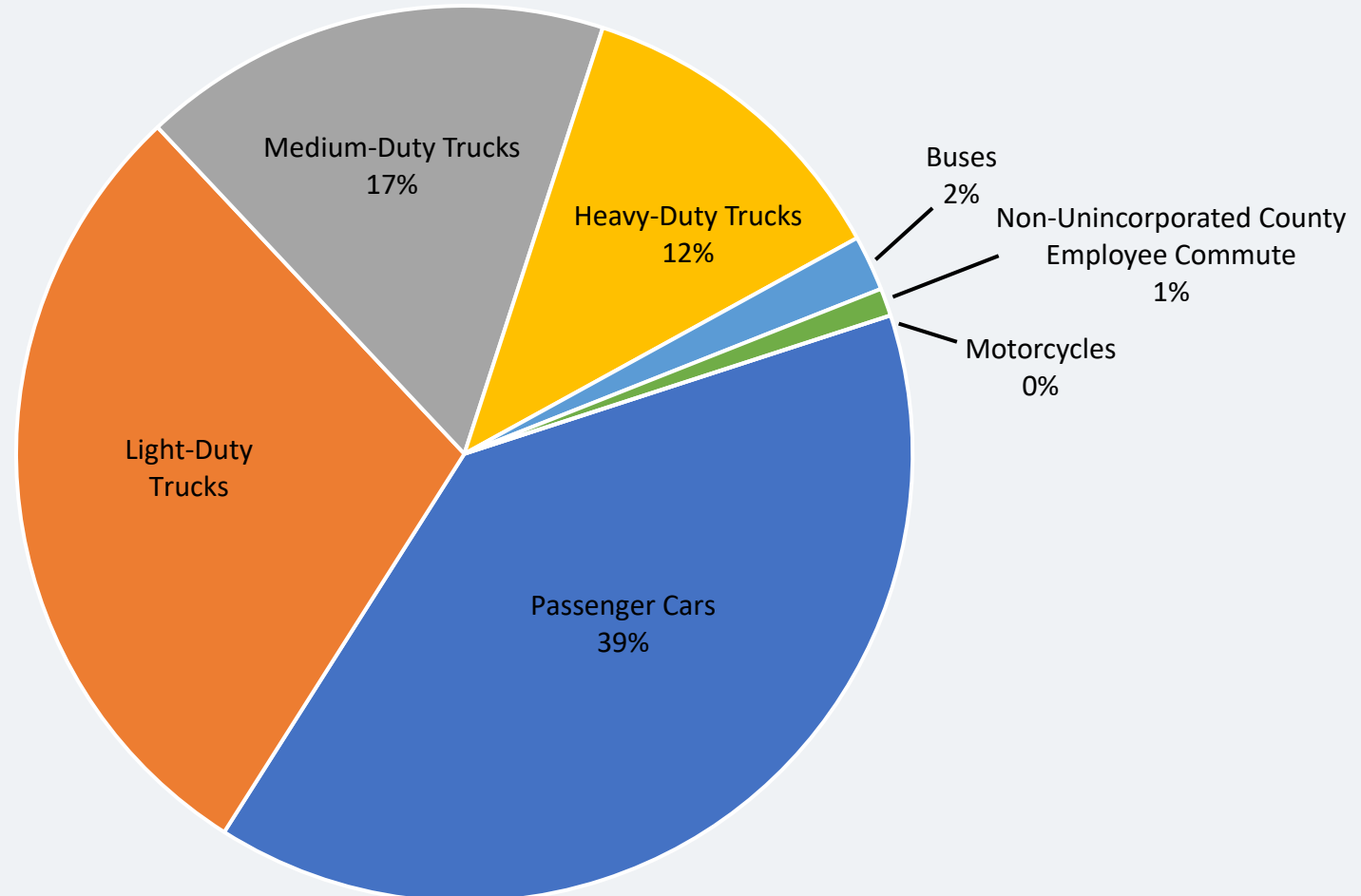

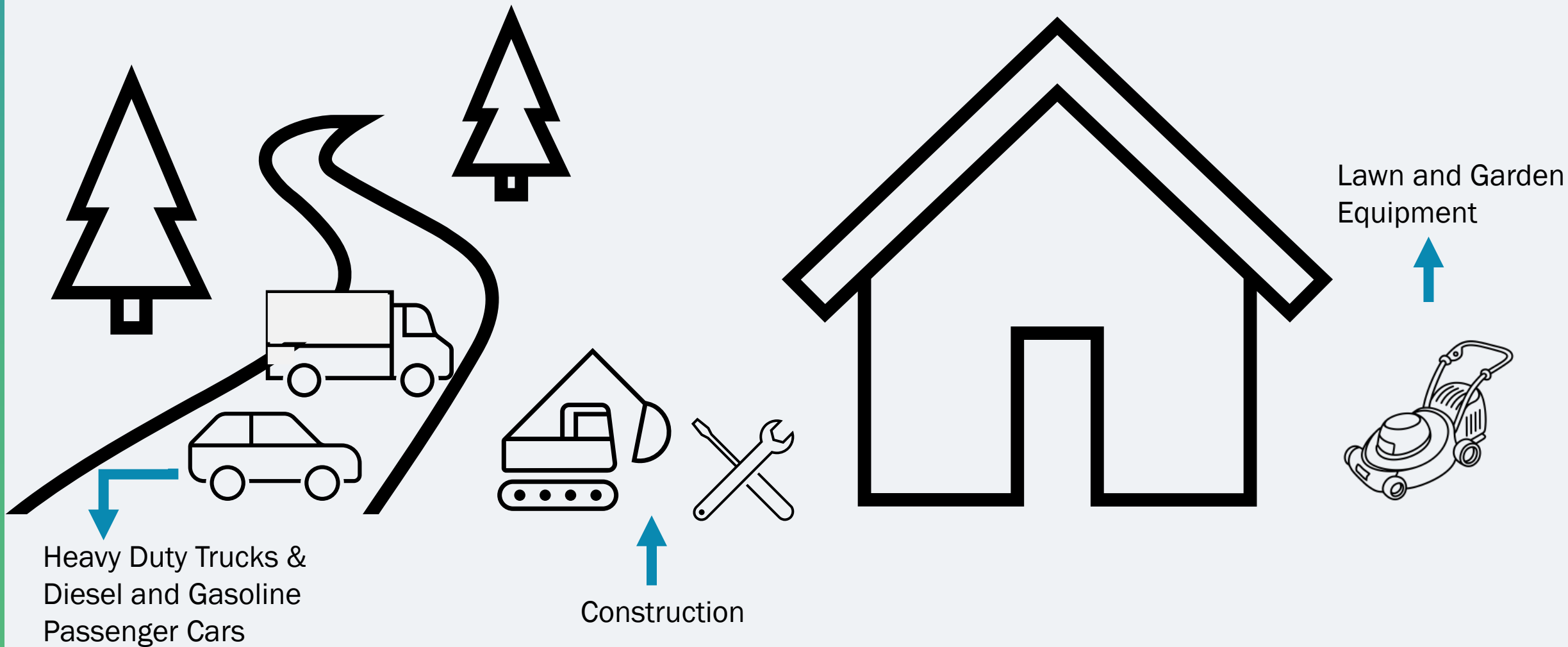

Breakdown of emissions from on-road transportation in the built environment/transportation sector (2014)



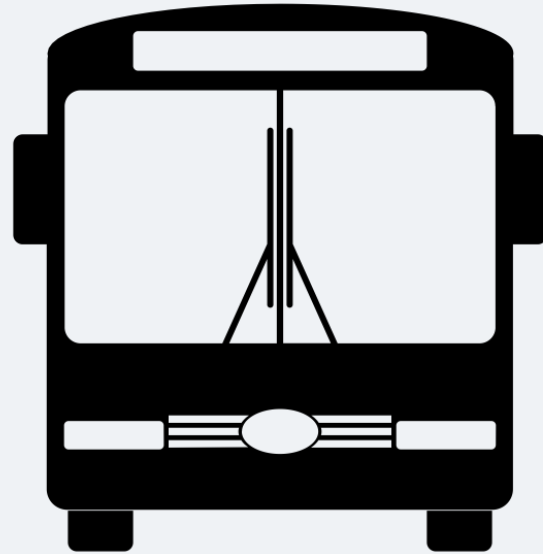
Built environment/transportation emissions residential level

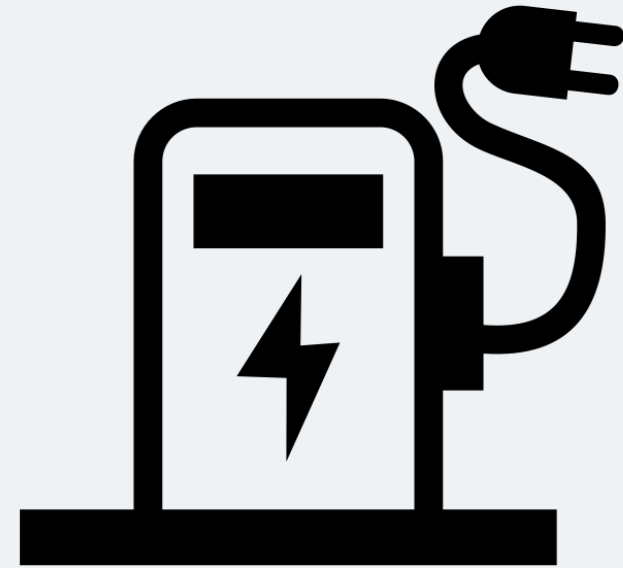

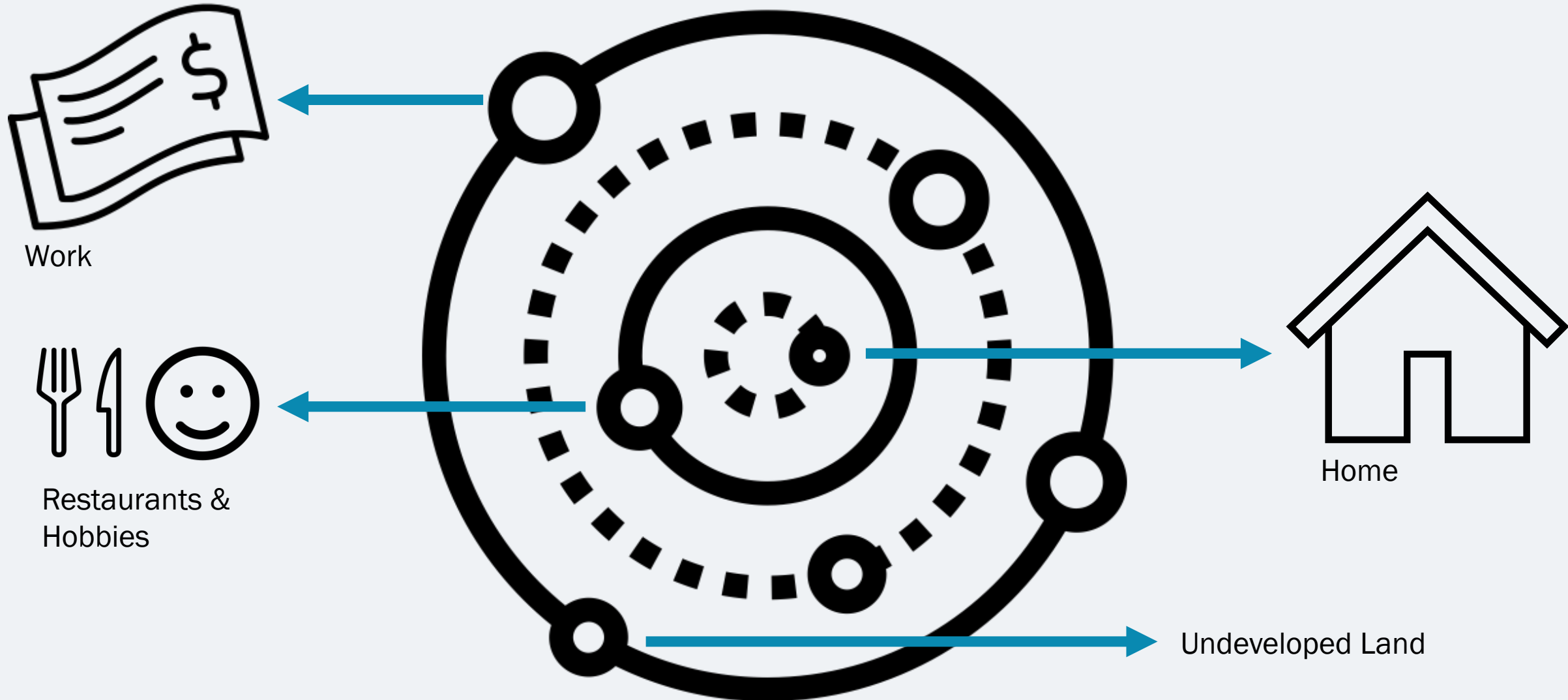

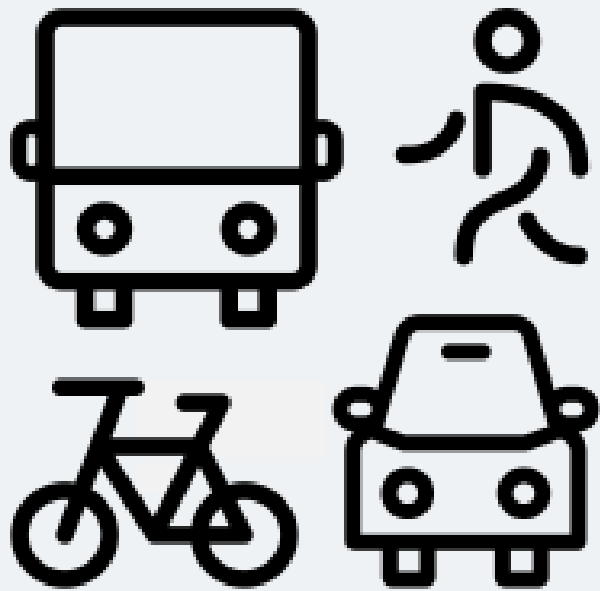

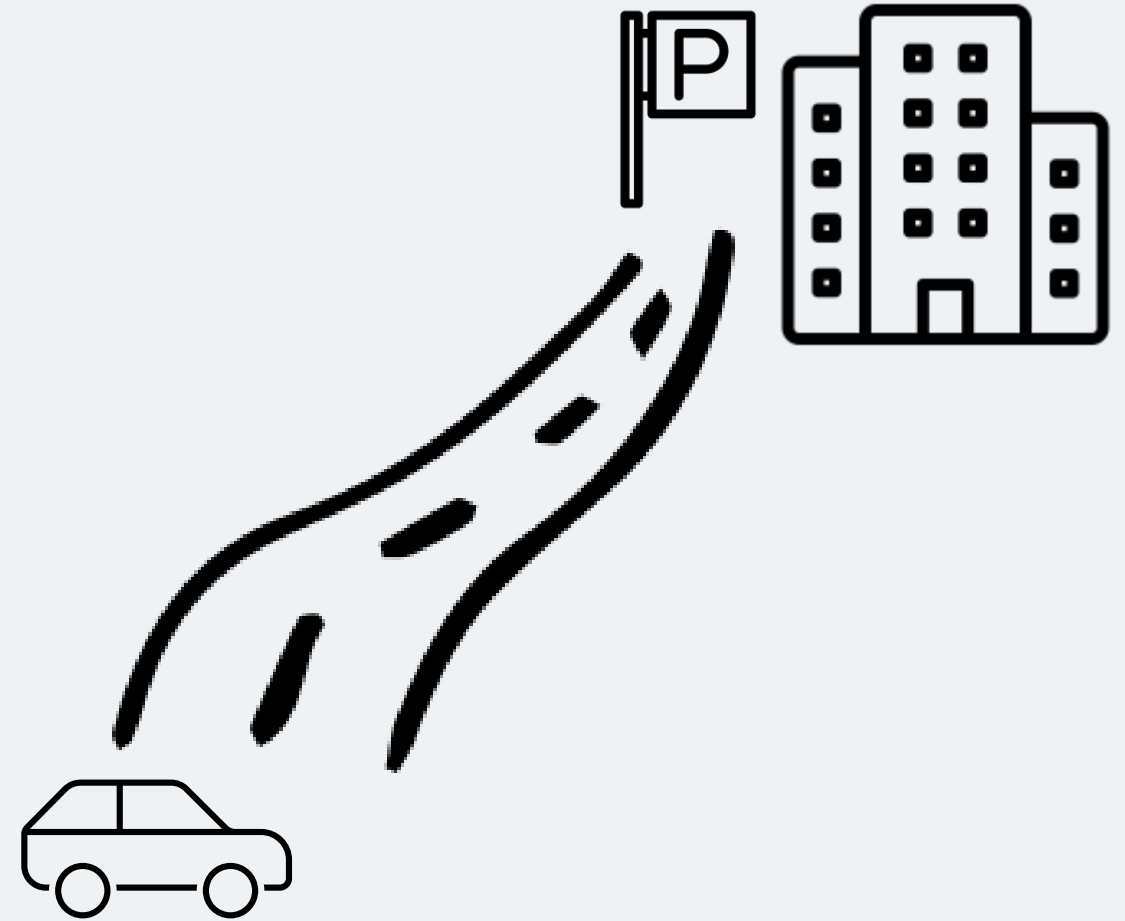

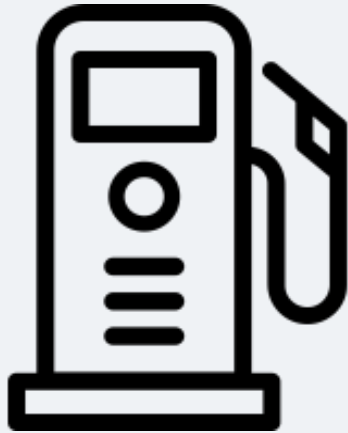

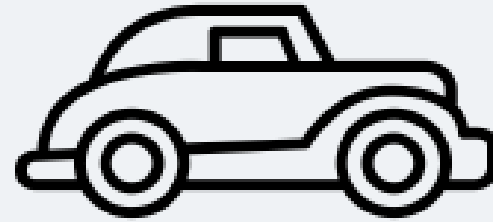
