Election Services Division: 15 Poll Workers wavied their stipend (a total of \$2,137.50). 5849

Pollworkers received a stipend (total paid \$782,505.00). Poll Workers worked an average of 16.5

hours on Election Day for the November 2014 Election (Total hours = 96,756).

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Technical Services Division: A total of $\underline{41 \text{ volunteers}}$ worked election night (11/04/14) for an average of $\underline{5 \text{ hours}}$ each (Total hours = 205). Not eligible for stipend.

Precinct Services: The County has 4 languages covered by the National Voting Rights Act that require us to provide facsimile ballots at the polls translated into: Hindi, Japanese, Khmer and Korean. 6. RECRUITING:

Please describe your recruiting programs:

Technical Services Division: 41 volunteers were recruited to work election night. Of these 41 volunteers, 36 were regular/perm county employees recruited via the county's email system and 'word-of-mouth'. The remaining 5 volunteers were non-county employees referred to us by county employees.

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Precinct Services: We recruit poll sites in various ways: Mail and phone communications with school districts, community college districts; personal in the field recruitment.

Election Services Division: Recruitment staff contacted over 10,000 poll workers via telephone, email and USPS mail to fill 5849 poll worker positions; this number includes the outreaching performed to 36 state employees, 844 local high school students, 408 local college students and 449 San Diego County workers. Appointment letters were sent with assigned poll location for Election Day and training was assigned to every poll worker.
