As Park Host, Diana is responsible for the day to day operations at the campground. She helps ensure that Vallecito is a pristine campground that is enjoyed by many visitors, thanks to her great customer service skills. The park has a historic stage station which Diana maintains and preserves. When a big winter storm damaged the stage station earlier this year, she was a huge help to the department by documenting the damage and working on the historic building to preserve it and prevent further damage. She became a certified Archaeological Technician to supplement her skills and abilities dealing with the cultural resources at Vallecito and uses these skills to identify, protect and interpret the significant resources at the stage station. She has done extensive research into the local history and provides quality interpretive tours.
