**Don Breitinger is a park host for the Ramona Preserves. Through approximately 4,000 plus volunteer hours, he has brought a vast amount of construction knowledge and experience with his integrity and an unmatched work ethic. Don mows and maintains fire clearances on approximately 20 acres every week, removing dangerous trees, repairing engines and pretty much anything else that breaks. He singlehandedly patched, repaired and painted a restroom building and all stucco walls at Boulder Oaks Preserve, a project which saved the department thousands of dollars while enhancing the appearance of the office area in preparation for a public opening. He has assisted and instructed a California Conservation Corps Crew in replacing a large section of fence along the trails of Ramona Grasslands Preserve which protects sensitive areas while actively pursuing the balance of public access and habitat protection.**
