Please be advised that the County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health and Quality Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency has received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment per Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21665(c). This public notice was prepared pursuant to 27 CCR Section 21660.1.

Project Description

Otay Landfill is an existing municipal solid waste landfill permitted under a full Solid Waste Facilities Permit issued on June 26, 2017. The application package to amend the RFI, in the form of a Joint Technical Document (JTD), corrects grammatical errors and assessor's parcel number; updates disposal capacity, estimated closure date, existing topography and liner footprint drawings, LEA contact information, precipitation and temperature tables, surrounding land use and zoning map, references to other regulatory permits, and incorporates a reference to Otay Landfill Compost Operation, a description of the organic waste measurements and record keeping procedures required pursuant to SB-1383 Short-lived Climate Pollutants: Organic Waste Reductions Regulations, and Physical Contamination Limit requirements.

The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit.
