

# Refugee Health Assessment Program (RHAP)

The Refugee Health Assessment Program provides a directed health assessment to refugees within the first 3 months of their arrival in San Diego.

Services include:

- Tuberculin skin test (TST) - < 2 yrs. of age
- QuantiFERON blood test (QFT) -  $\geq$  2 yrs. of age
- Treatment for tuberculosis infection/disease
- Screening/testing for:
  - Anemia
  - Lead exposure
  - Pregnancy testing
  - Hepatitis B and C
  - HIV and syphilis
  - Stool for ova and parasites
- Assessment of mental health status
- Comprehensive physical examination
- Health education
- Referral to health care
