

Final Actions of San Diego Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee June 2, 2005

1. The IGLCBC approved reimbursing County for administrative costs of \$9,366 to be taken from the County Tribal Account of \$4,989,452.70.
2. The IGLCBC reviewed the applications sponsored by Barona, Sycuan and Viejas Bands in a letter dated May 17, 2005, and approved funding all the projects listed on that letter. Project allocations total \$4,980,086.70, as shown below:
 - Joint application by six East County Fire Protection Districts (Alpine San Miguel, San Diego Rural, Ramona and Lakeside): \$966,498 for improved emergency services.
 - County Department of Public Works: \$1,765,000 for Wildcat Canyon Improvement Project.
 - County Department of Public Works: \$600,000 for Willow Road Shoulder Improvements in residential area.
 - San Diego County District Attorney's Office: \$100,000 for the tribal liaison project.
 - County of San Diego Health and Human Services Agency – Emergency Medical Services: \$75,000 to augment County's subsidy for paramedic services in east and north county.
 - Intermountain Fire Department: \$85,171 to enlarge new fire station to house emergency vehicles.
 - San Pasqual Fire Department (CSA 113): \$7,889 for helmets and boots for 30 firefighters.
 - Boulevard Fire and Rescue Department (CSA 111): \$64,650 to upgrade breathing apparatus of firefighters.
 - City of San Diego Fire-Rescue Department: \$250,000 for Helicopter Fuel Servicing Vehicle acquisition to serve entire region.
 - Zone 7 San Diego Rural Fire Agencies and Zone 8 Inland Fire Agencies: \$463,100 to cover cost of dispatch fees for FY 05/06.
 - City of El Cajon Public Works Department: \$120,000 for installation of traffic signal and safety lighting system at Washington/Dehesa Rd. and Granite Hills Drive.
 - City of El Cajon Fire Department: \$437,762.70 for acquisition of one Type 1 Fire Pumper.
 - Heartland Communications Authority: \$45,016 for enhanced training on Medical Reports Management Systems for members of its Joint Powers Authority.
