

**SAN DIEGO COUNTY  
INDIAN GAMING LOCAL COMMUNITY BENEFIT COMMITTEE  
(IGLCBC) FY '04-'05 GRANT APPLICATIONS**

Revised May 19, 2004\*

The County of San Diego, acting as the Grant Administrator for the IGLCBC, received 18 eligible applications, and six (6) ineligible applications, by the application deadline of Friday, April 23, 2004. The breakdown of all applications by category is as follows:

- Type 1 (60% Nexus Grants): **6 Grant Applications** consisting of 1 application from the District Attorney's Office; 3 applications from the County Department of Public Works; 1 application from the County Office of Emergency Services (on behalf of Intermountain Volunteer Fire Department; and 1 application from the Department of the Sheriff
- Type 2 (20% Non-Nexus Grants): **14 Grant Applications** including 3 applications from the County of San Diego that are also eligible for Type 1 grant funding; and 3 applications from the County of San Diego that are also eligible for Type 1 and 3 grant funding.
- Type 3 (20% Non-Nexus Grants): **13 Grant Applications** including 3 applications from the County of San Diego that are also eligible for Type 1 and Type 2 grant funding; 5 applications from the City of San Diego and one application from the San Diego Rural Fire Protection District that are also eligible for Type 2 grant funding.
- Six (6) Ineligible Grant Applications

The IGLCBC Log lists all applications by category of grants with two attachments: Attachment A contains a list of grant applications that were mis-categorized and/or needed corrections; and Attachment B lists the six ineligible applications. Applicants of these applications have been sent letters stating the reason they were determined to be ineligible is because they are not considered "jurisdictions" pursuant to SB 621, i.e. not a city, county or special district.
