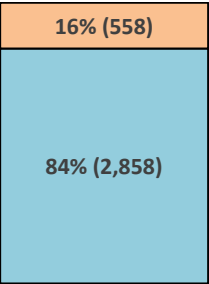

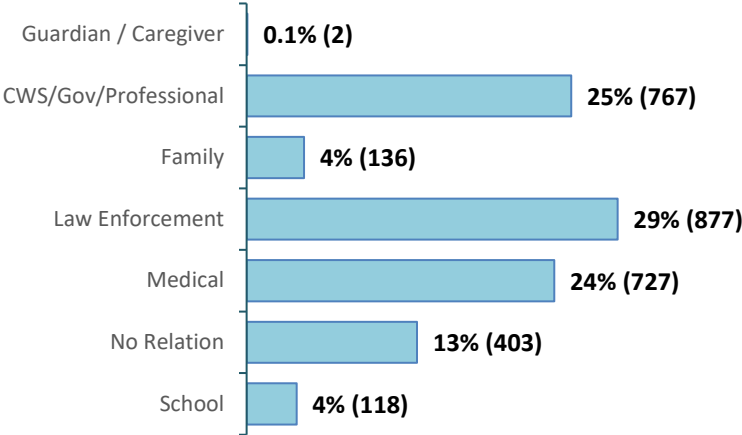

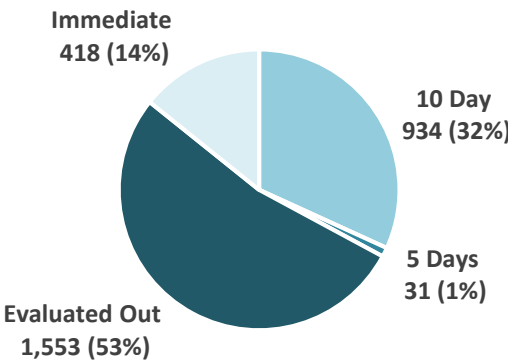

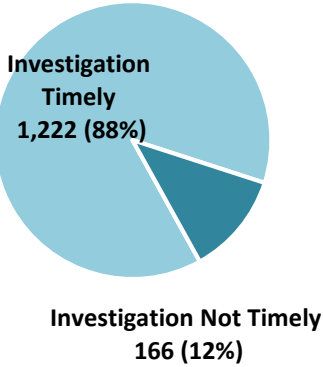

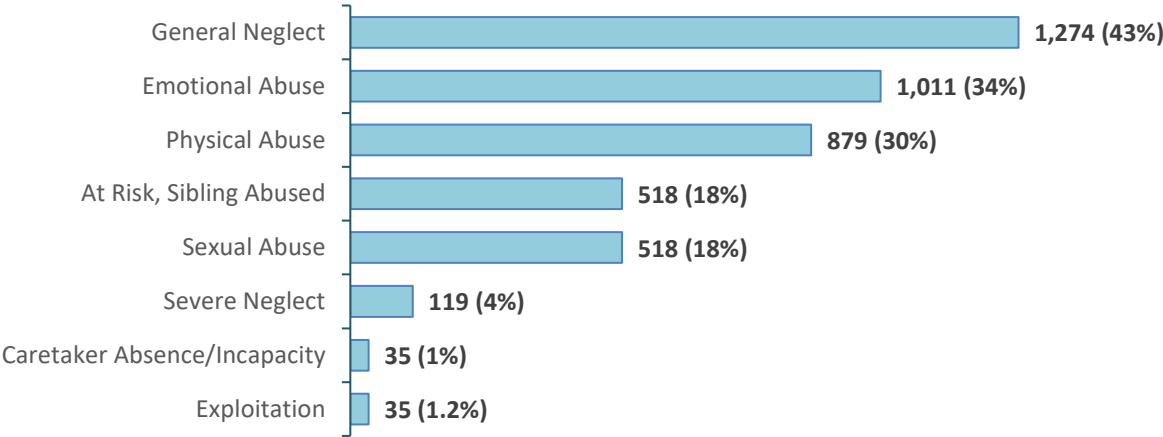
REFERRAL RESPONSE TYPE

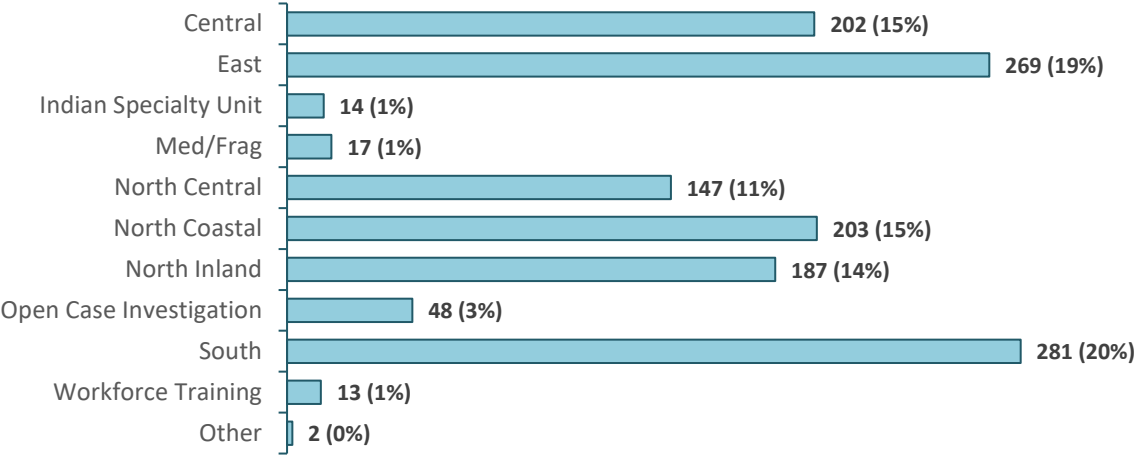


ALLEGATION TYPE

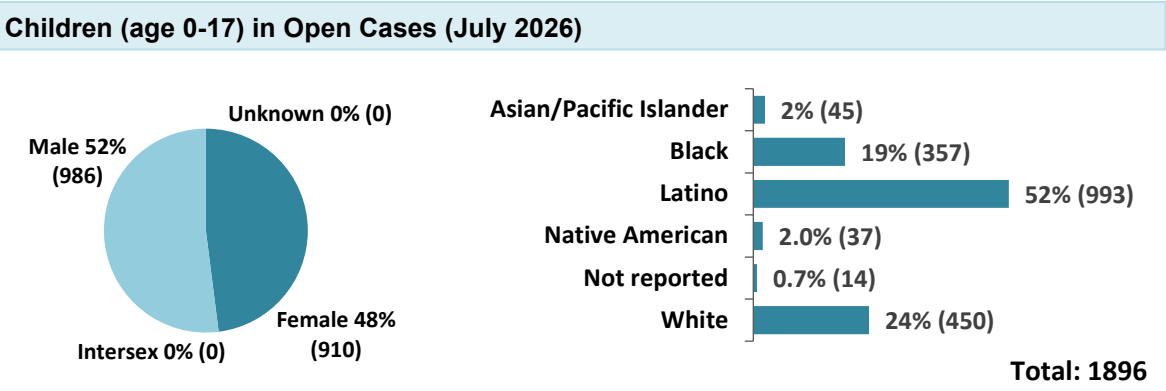

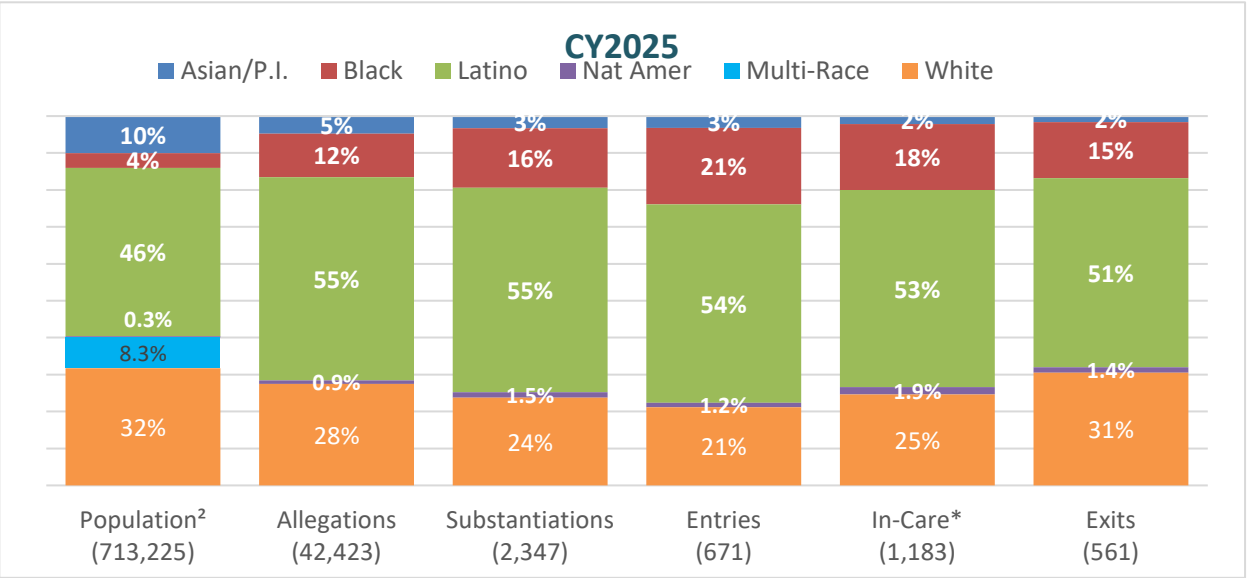

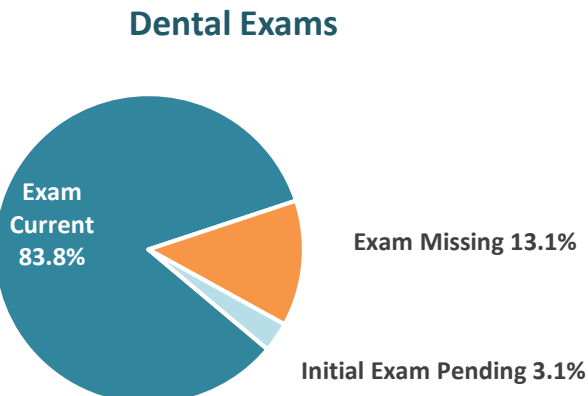
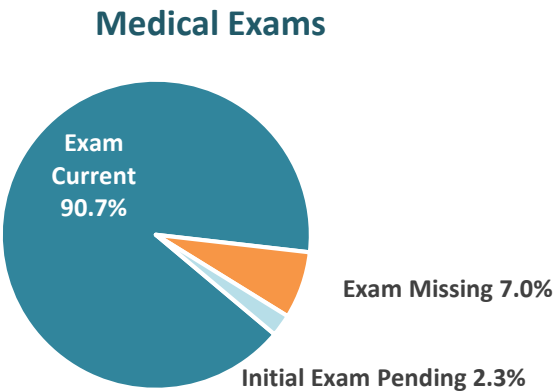


Polinsky / Adoption Finalizations / Petitions / Medical & Dental Exams - Monthly Averages (July 2026)

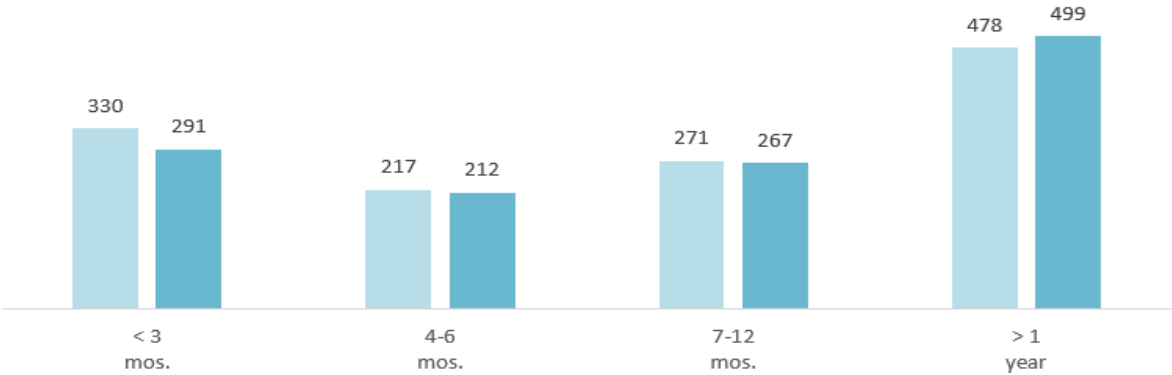

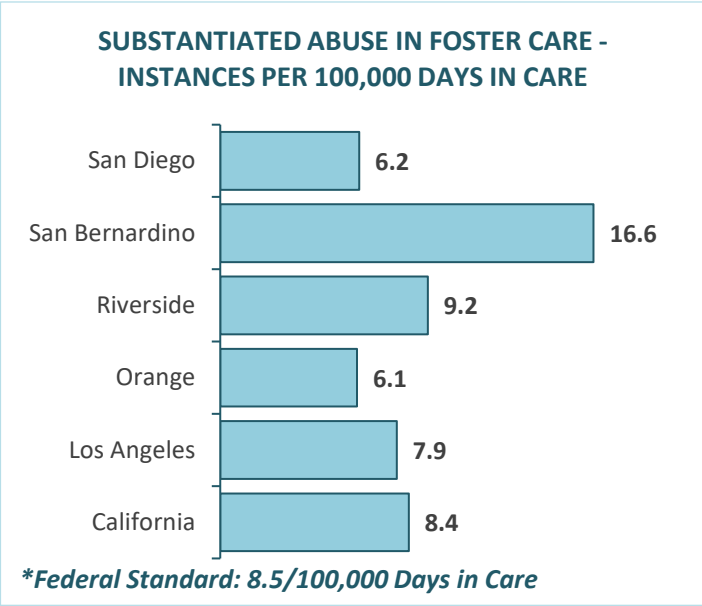
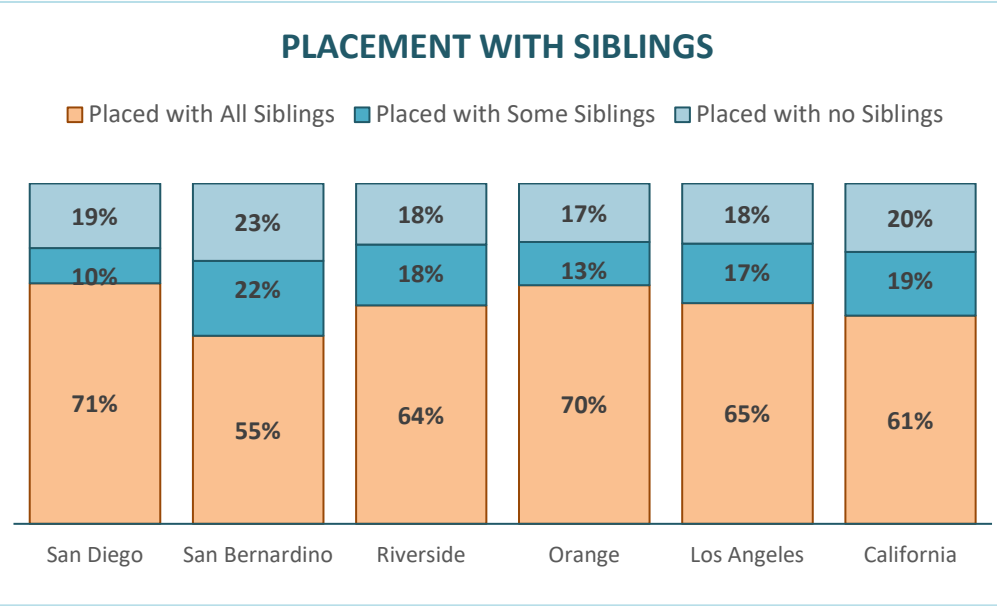
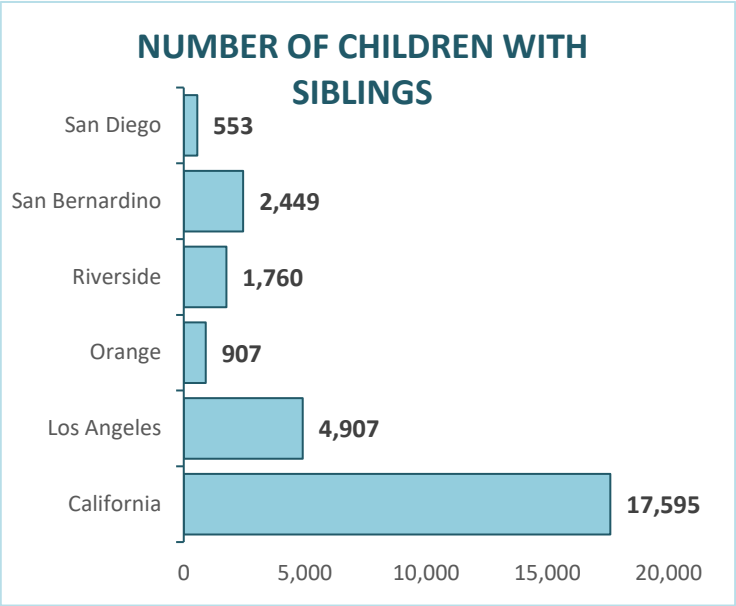
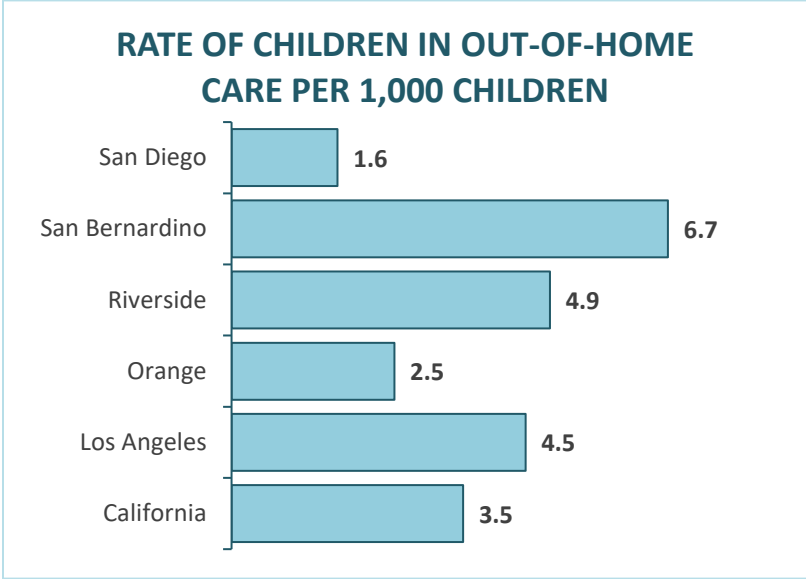
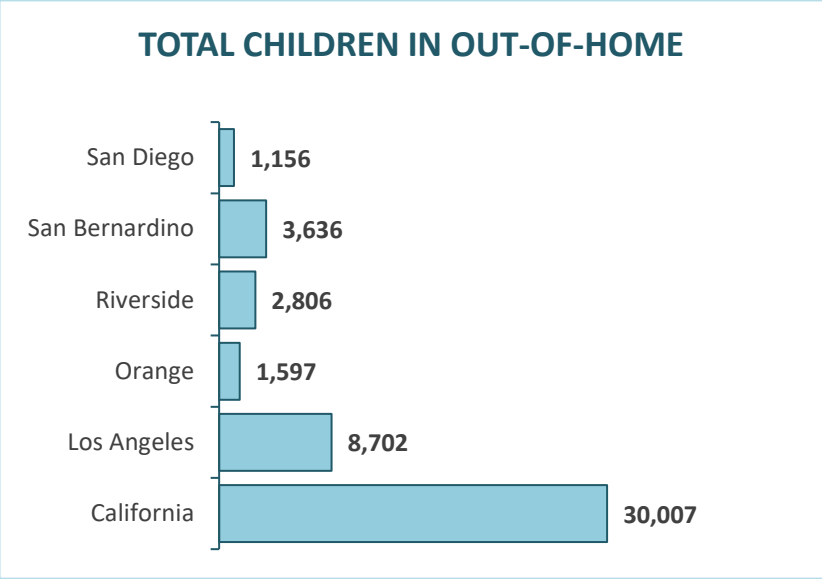
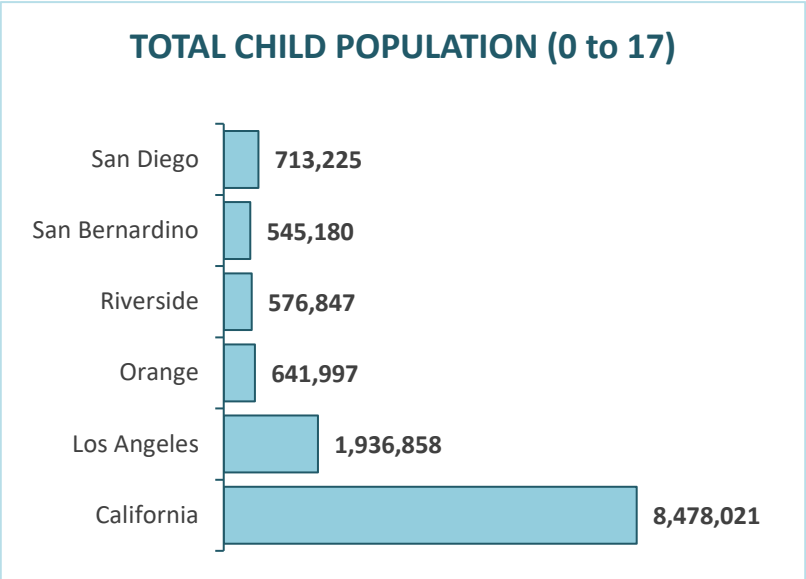
RATE OF SUBSTANTIATED ABUSE IN FOSTER CARE APR2026-MAR2026

Placements - Five counties with the highest child population comparison (On April 01, 2026)

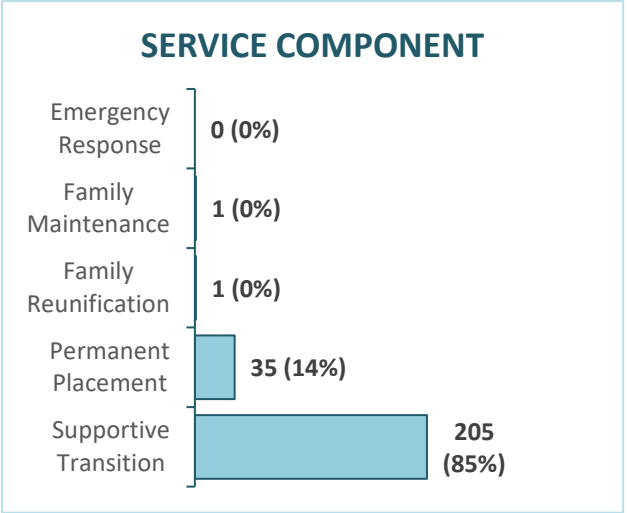
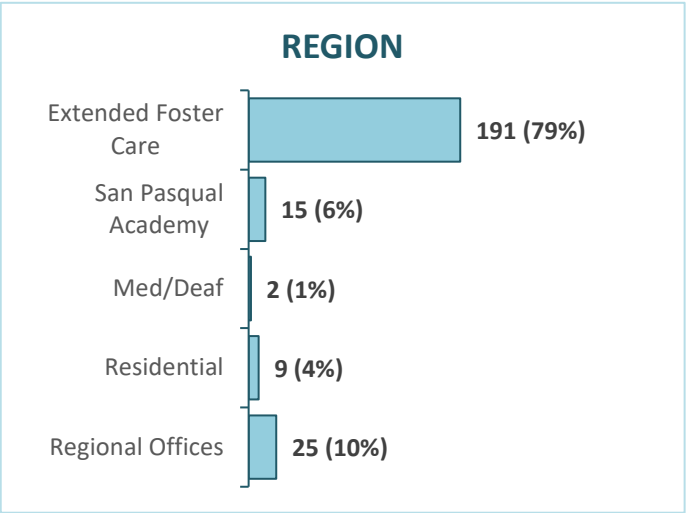
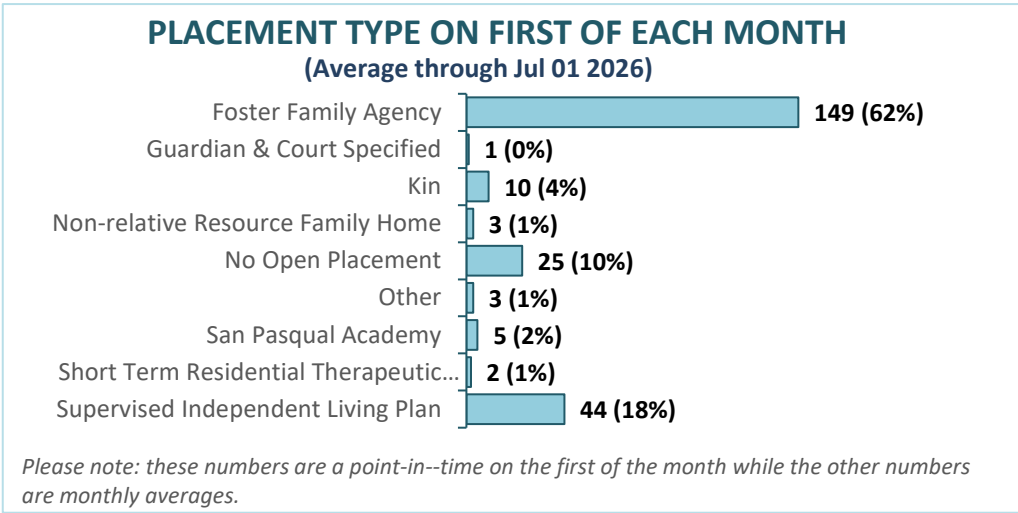
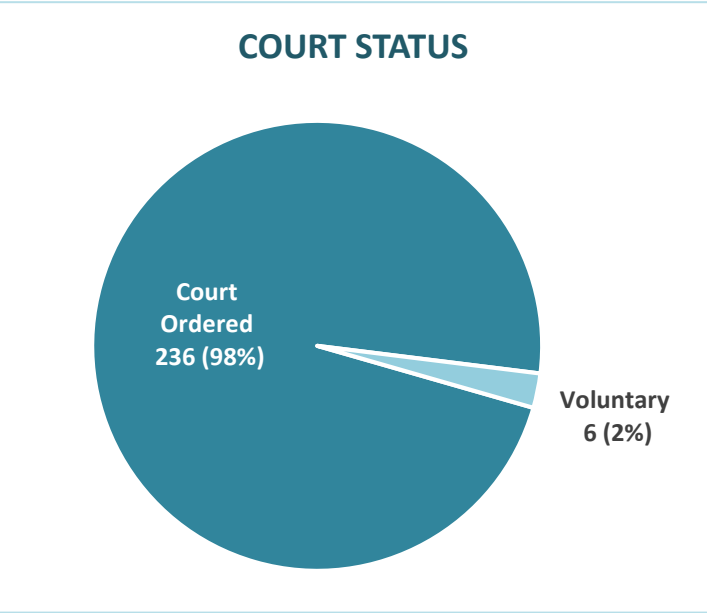
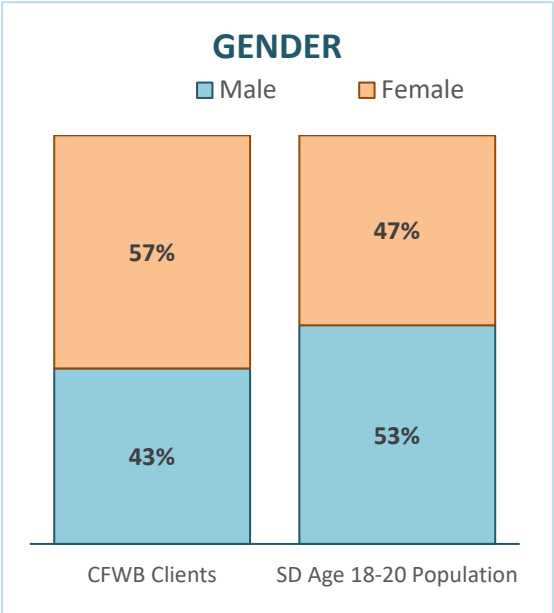
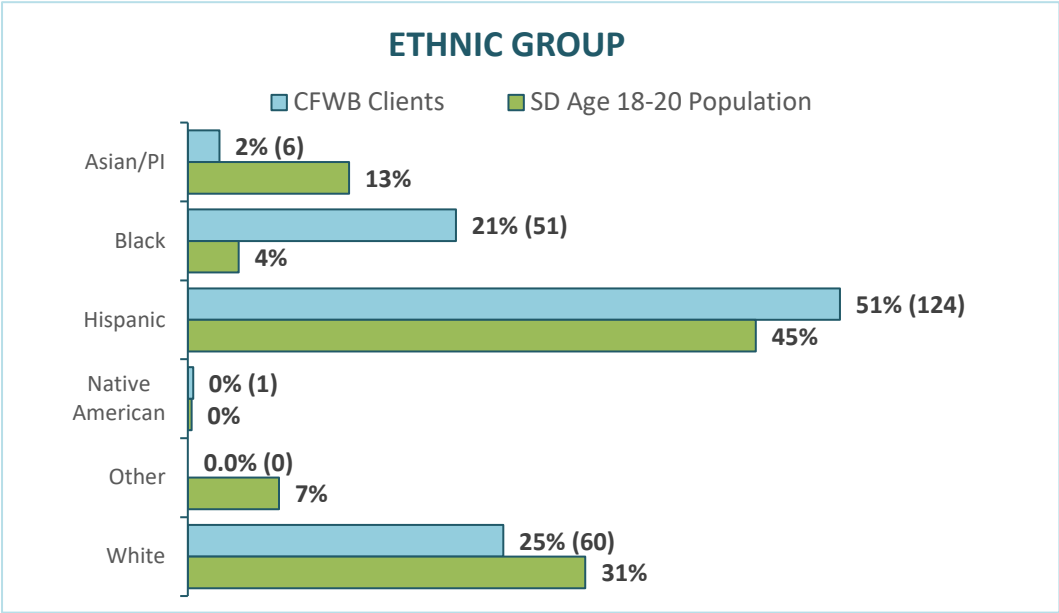
